Perhaps the most misunderstood or underappreciated white grape in the world of wine. Once upon a time, Riesling was once the most prized wine on the planet. Historically, we can look at Titanic's 1st class wine list, where Riesling was the most expensive bottle on the ship. Its reputation and quality took a nose dive due to WW1 & WW2.

Since then, vineyards have been replanted, on the rebound and putting these wines back to their world class levels. While most bottlings from Germany do lean towards the sweeter end of the spectrum, some can be much drier in style.

Alsace, France has a reputation for leaning toward a drier style that is absent of any sugar and is incredibly refreshing. For those interested in being adventurous, Alsatian Riesling can be as crisp as Sauvignon Blanc but pack an incredible minerality that brightens up any course. No matter the decision you make, you will reap the rewards!

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SAUVIGNON BLANC

Sauvignon Blanc or “Wild White” is certainly that. Eccentric, boisterous, loud and proud. Sauvignon Blanc was born in France and has a permanent residence in the village of Sancerre. Sancerre showcases the earth from which the grapes grew, displaying a crisp mineral palate and subtle citrus that is more tame than its New Zealand counterpart.

Speaking of, it has also found homes in Bordeaux, Napa Valley and New Zealand.

New Zealand has risen in popularity due to its zesty grapefruit flavor backed by a refreshing herbaceousness. Napa has built itself on a creamier, richer style that often sees a touch of vanilla due to some new oak usage. Lastly Bordeaux, is both deeply earthy and has a richer texture than its northern neighbor in Sancerre.

Chardonnay from California has long been a staple in the US and still today is the most planted grape. California has hung its proverbial hat on full bodied, rich and opulent “butter bombs”. As of recently, we are seeing a swing towards lighter, brighter, crisp expressions and everything in between. Still the most celebrated grape, buyers have limitless options in the style they prefer.

While Oregon’s first go around with Chardonnay was a “disaster”, winemakers have found new success with the grape; Chardonnay is starting to put itself in place as Oregon’s leading white grape, surplanting Pinot Gris. While typically lighter than its California neighbor to the south, make no mistake these wines pack flavor.

PINOT NOIR

Pinot Noir from Oregon, has been the state's flagship grape since it was first commercially planted in the late 1960's. Additionally, this thin skinned grape has earned recognition in 1979 from blind tasting competitions held in France. Similarly to Oregon Chardonnay, it provides a "bridge" that connects California Pinot Noir to French Pinot Noir (Burgundy), striking an incredible balance between rich fruit and powerful earth tones.

California Pinot Noir didn't truly see its rise to glory until after the 2004 film, *Sideways*. Pinot Noir was always in the shadow of Cabernet Sauvignon and even Merlot. One incredibly impactful Hollywood scene, "flipped the script" as they say and plummeted Merlot overnight and gave a meteoric rise and financial influx to California Pinot Noir. Pinot Noir from California is richly textured, fruit forward, easy drinking and a versatile wine throughout any meal.

Spanish wines offer a remarkable step into European wines for those who have played it “safe”, only sticking to wines from California. There is an ocean of flavor for those willing to explore it. France's famed region of Rhone can broadly be split into Northern and Southern Rhone. Both Northern and Southern Rhone wines are rich and powerful and are remarkable options for rich entrees.

Northern Rhone is focused on the Syrah grape and is dark in color. It will display roasted black fruits, rich herbs and an unmistakable element of spice and game.

Southern Rhone focuses on blends, predominantly consisting of Grenache, Syrah and Mourvedre (aka GSM blend). Wines will look lighter in color but will not be light in flavor. Roasted strawberry, dried oranges/lavender and black tea will lead the charge in this full bodied South of France red.

Bordeaux is often looked at as the undisputed heavyweight of French red wines. The term “Bordeaux Blend” owes its name to the city located in Southwest France. The reds from Bordeaux are ALWAYS a blend, usually with Cabernet Sauvignon or Merlot leading the charge, followed by Cabernet Franc, Petit Verdot and Malbec sitting in the back seat.

The success of Cabernet Sauvignon (and Merlot!) has spread globally due to the reputation that Bordeaux has held for centuries. Black and red fruits are present, however, these wines are gravelly, dusty and full of savory herbs. Pencil shavings, cedar, leather and cigar box are all notes that your glass of Bordeaux will give you.

Argentina has earned its status on the Malbec grape, particularly in the region of Mendoza. For the sake of conversation, Mendoza is Argentina's "Napa Valley". The wines are big and full of dark fruit that are rich and round. These wines are absolutely perfect for a large cut of steak, which makes perfect sense coming from a country where the population consumes more beef per person than anywhere else in the world.

To Argentina's West, Chile, has a knack for full bodied wines that are built on Cabernet Sauvignon and Carmenere. The wines have proven to be consistent winners in competitions all over the world. This has brought in financial interest and support from some of the world's greatest winemakers and wineries. Chilean reds are deliciously comparable to Napa Cabs and carry a distinct herbaceous note, adding to their aromatic freshness.

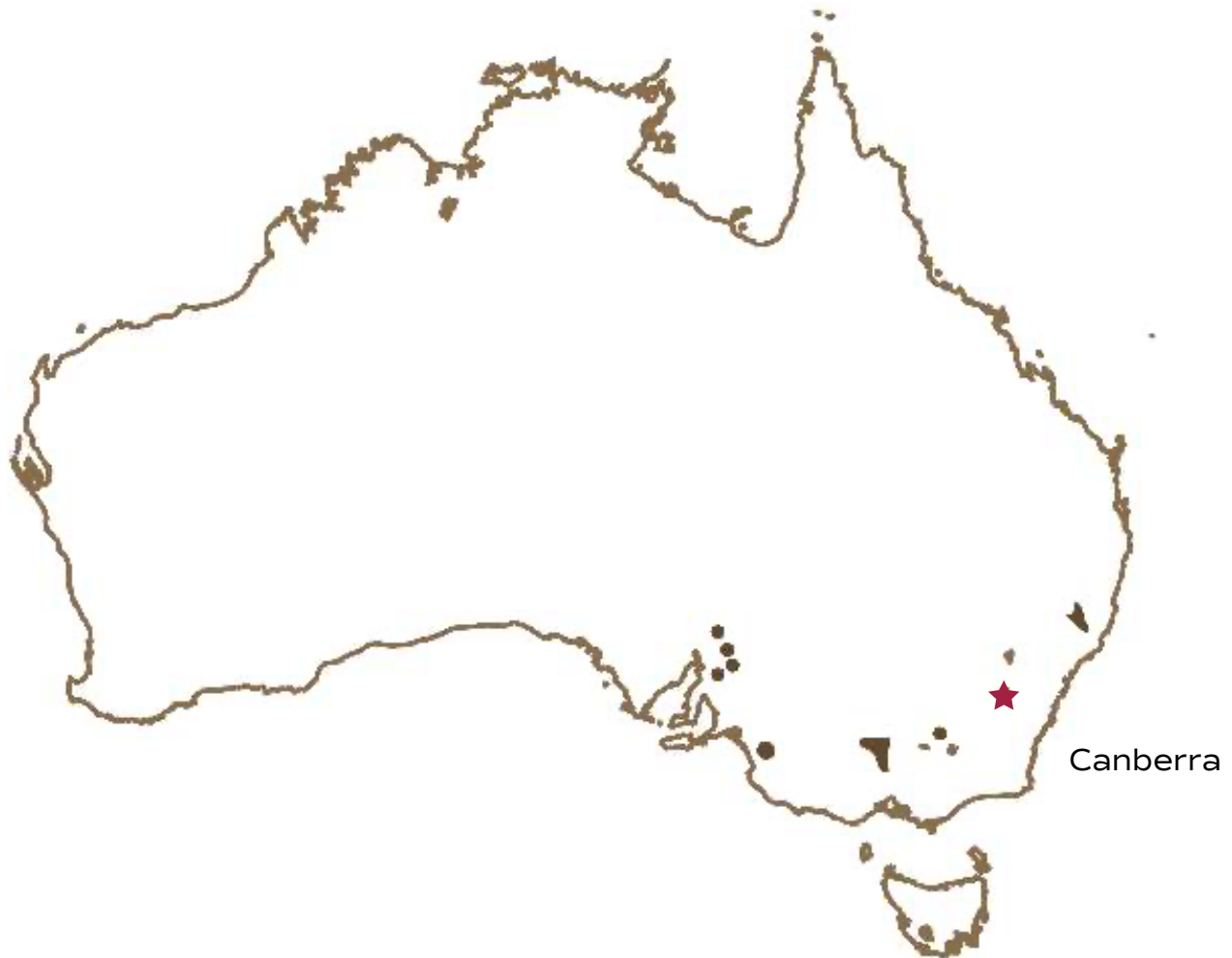

While wine has been made here for much longer, proof in its vineyards that date back to the 1850's, it only has "recently" made dry red wines. Shiraz, Australian Syrah, has emerged as the leader of the pack with Cabernet Sauvignon and Grenache nipping at its heels. Most Shiraz are characterized by sappy blackberries and boysenberries. Additionally, the country is full of "Gum Trees" (Eucalyptus trees) and the pollen often blows into vineyards giving many reds a subtle element of mint/menthol.

California Cabernet Sauvignon is perhaps the most familiar red wine for any Steakhouse diner in the United States. The classic catch phrase, “a Cab and a Slab” did not come out of thin air. These wines have a reputation of big flavors and big weight, making perfect sense for a hearty steak pairing.

Recently however, many California Cabernets have been nearing almost 16% abv, which is nearly the alcohol content of Port. Those 16% monsters became hard to drink as they only tasted like alcohol and less like wine. A recent effort has been made from growers/winemakers for California Cabernet that is more restrained in an attempt to achieve better balance. Less alcohol, brighter fruit that doesn't lose concentration is a larger focus today and is getting back to what built California's reputation. While both options will continue to exist, one thing remains true: both styles only add to California's diversity and continued success!
